1.1 **SPORTING REGULATIONS**

The **Morris Lubricants Loton Park Championship** is organised and administered by the Hagley and District Light Car Club Ltd in accordance with the General Regulations of the Royal Automobile Club Motor Sports Association (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA) and these Championship Regulations.

1.3 **COMPETITOR ELIGIBILITY.**

- 1.3.1 Entrants must be fully paid up valid membership card holding members of the **Hagley & District Light Car Club Ltd** and be in possession of valid 2008 MSA Entrants Licence.
- 1.3.2 Drivers and Entrant/Drivers must be fully paid up valid membership card holding members of the **Hagley & District Light Car Club Ltd**, be Registered for the Championship and be in possession of a valid Competition (Non-Race) National B Licence as a minimum.
- 1.3.3 All necessary documentation must be presented for checking at all rounds when signing-on.

1.4 REGISTRATION.

1.4.1 Competitors must register for the Championship using the official registration form attached, and send it to:

1.4.2 The registration fee for the Championship is **£20.00**.

1.4.3 To be eligible to score points in the Championship, all vehicles must display a minimum of two Championship decals, which will be provided in accordance with General Regulations **C(a)-55**.

1.5.2 At **National A/B** split permit events, priority will be given to British, Leaders and Midland entrants and, in the event of a full entry of such, the Championship may not be run.

1.5.3 Regulations for all events will be available from the event Entries Secretary.

1.6 SCORING

1.6.1 **Loton Park Championship** contenders will be split into three classes as follows:

Class 1 Competitors new to Loton Park

Class 2 Competitors who have previously competed at Loton Park, but do not qualify for Class 3.

Class 3 Competitors who have competed in the Loton Park Championship for 3, or more, years in the same car.

There will also be an **FTD Championship**, for which **ALL** registered entrants are eligible regardless of Class.

1.6.1.1. Each Competitor will be given a **“Target Time”** prior to the competitive runs at his/her first qualifying event. This **“Target Time”** will be adjusted for each subsequent event, to reflect the competitor’s best time recorded during the season or at the discretion of the Championship Co-ordinator.

1.6.1.2. Competitors in Classes 1 will be given a **“Target Time”** based on their **best practice time** plus 8 seconds, whilst Competitors in Classes 2 & 3, who competed in the previous year’s Championship in the same vehicle, will have their **“Target Time”** set from their **best time recorded** plus 8 seconds.

3.3 All vehicles **MUST** comply with the **MSA** safety regulations.
