LOTON PARK MEMBERS` PRACTICE DAYS 20th/21st MARCH 2010 **SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS**

1) The Hagley & District Light Car Club will hold two Members Practice Days at Loton Park Hill Climb on Saturday 20th March & Sunday 21st March 2010.

Loton Park is situated in the village of Alberbury on the B4393 road, off the A458 Shrewsbury-Welshpool road. SY5 9AG, OS Map reference 126/358143.

2) Clubmans Event Permit Numbers...20th March-55803 21st March-56610

3) The events are governed by the General Regulations of the Motor Sports Association 2010 Year Book (Incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA), these supplementary regulations and any written instructions issued by the organising Club for the event.

4) The course is 1475 yards in length, with left and right hand corners.

5) Persons eligible:- All fully paid up members of H.& D.L.C.C holding a current MSA National B or higher grade competition licence.

6) Entries open on publication and **close on Saturday 6th March 2010.**

The maximum number will be 80 entries each day, and the minimum 30.

You can enter both days, but if either or both days are over-subscribed, you may only be offered an entry on one day, which will be advised to you with final instructions.

Final instructions plus provisional entry list and allocation of your competition number will be sent immediately after the closing date.

A car may be entered for two drivers in accordance with MSA Regulations.

Acknowledgement of entry will be sent within seven days of receipt of entry.

7) The Entry fee is £84.00 for one day or £168.00 for both days.

A proportion of this fee is allocated for the upkeep of Midland Hill Climb Rescue Units and to fund the administration of the Midland Marshals Championship

8) Non-Starters will be due a refund (subject to the Secretary being notified):-

5 or more days prior to the event:- Full refund less £15.00 admin. charge.

Less than 5 days prior to the event- : Refund of Insurance & per capita fees only, on application to the Secretary up to 7 days after the event.

9) Please note Driving Gloves are mandatory for 2010

10) Silencing:- All cars must be silenced as per MSA Regulations.

11) Tyre Warmers:- The use of any external device or power source to pre-heat tyres of a competing car is prohibited. Tyre warming is only allowed by spinning wheels in the pre-start area as designated by signage.

12) Competition Numbers must be displayed on both sides and front of the car Numbers must NOT be displayed on the car when being driven on the roads.

Black adhesive numbers will be available for purchase at the Paddock Office.

13) Walking the Course:- It is strongly recommended that all competitors walk the course before practice, and/or during the lunch break.

14) Event Procedure:-

On arrival at the venue, park your car (and trailer if applicable) in the designated area. Motorhomes are not allowed to park in the Paddock area. Signing-on will be from 8.00 am at the Paddock Office (all competitors must produce a valid competition licence and current Club membership card).

Scrutineering will take place from 8.00 am (in your Paddock position).

Please do not run competition car engines before 9.00 am.

First time drivers to Loton Park will be called to a briefing at 9.00 am,

Practice commences at 9.30 am both days.

You will be called to the assembly area (in numerical order) in batches of approximately 30 cars. These will be announced over the Public Address, and a list will be displayed in the Paddock. Please be ready to come when called.

There will be a lunch break at approximately 1.00 pm.

No cooking appliances i.e. primus stoves/gas burners are allowed in the Paddock area.

There will be no separate classes and no awards will be given.

Times and split times will be available on the day, and a printed summary of times will be posted to you after the event.

15) A RED flag means STOP and await instructions to proceed.

16) Loton Park is a Deer Park .Please respect the rural nature of the surroundings .Put ALL litter in the appropriate bins, or take it home with you.

17) Overnight Camping is allowed in the park at a cost of £7.50 per unit (see entry form for payment details). The park must be vacated within two hours of completion of the event.

18) Dogs-: Members of the public will not be allowed to bring dogs into the park, but competitors can bring dogs in on the following basis-:

During the event, dogs must be kept out-of-sight of the Paddock and Trackside areas.

Outside the hours of the event (from one hour before the course is open and 30 minutes after it is closed), dogs may be exercised in the park within the area designated. Dogs must be kept on a lead at all times. If a dog brought in by a competitor or anyone connected with a competitor is found to be worrying the deer or game, the owner will be asked to remove the dog from the Park immediately, and the Loton Park gamekeeper will be within his rights to take appropriate action.

We are indebted to Sir Michael Leighton for making this concession, which could be withdrawn if the above conditions are not adhered to.
