

Hybrid and Electric Cars at Loton Park Hill Climb in 2019 :

In September 2017 the MSA issued guidance to organisers of speed events for the running of Hybrid and Electric Cars, since when there have been no updates.

The Hagley and District Light Car Club have studied and discussed these guidelines very carefully and concluded that we are unable to comply with the current Motorsport UK requirements and demonstrate that we have adequate measures in place to control the risks with such vehicles.

We are therefore not able to accept entries for these vehicles at any of our competitive hill climbs or at any of our Driving Schools in 2019.

Update for 2020 :

Hybrid and Electric Cars at Loton Park Hill Climb in 2020 :

In 2017 the then Motor Sports Association issued guidance to organisers of Speed events for the running of Hybrid and Electric Cars. Motorsport UK have recently set up an Electrified Vehicles Working Group to develop technical and safety regulations for these cars.

We hope that the outcome will enable the Hagley & District Light Car Club to comply with suggested recommendations for running these cars at Loton Park in the future.

For the time being we are not able to accept entries for these vehicles at any of our competitive hillclimbs or at any of our Driving Schools in 2020.
