FOREWORD

This Sporting Trial is being held under the Covid-19 guidelines issued by the Government and Motorsport UK at the time of the event, so all communications are all electronic. Competitors The Motorsport UK signing on sheet for the event will be sent with entry acknowledgment and must be sent to the Secretary before the closing date. This form includes a declaration that your car is eligible for the event. The scrutineer will only examine selected cars if he/she thinks it necessary. Please read the Covid-19 part of the declaration before signing. We would ask that all competitors keep an accurate record of their scores. The provisional and final results will be computed using the Hill check sheets and will be sent to each competitor in the week following the event.

You will not be able to apply for the Motorsport UK RS Clubman Status licence at the event so please apply early to Motorsport UK to avoid disappointment. It is your responsibility to have your licence which has to be noted on your entry form. Please ensure that you bring your competition licence, championship registration form and club memberships cards with you for examination if required.

The event requires marshals, but like competitors they must register with the chief marshal and sign the Motorsport UK signing on sheet in advance of the event

The general section has several points specific to the running of the event, please read them before you come to the event.

SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

- 1.** The **Hagley & District Light Car Club Ltd** will organise a Clubmans status Sporting Trial on Sunday 20th February 2022, at The Apley Estate, Norton, Nr. Shifnal, Shropshire, TF11 9ED
- 2.** The Meeting will be governed by the General regulations of Motorsport UK, (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA), these Supplementary Regulations and any written instructions that the Club may issue before the event.
- 3.** **Motorsport UK** Permit number **124487** has been issued
- 4.** The event is open to all fully elected members of the organising club and members of the following invited clubs: **BTRDA, 750 Motor Club, NPTCC.**
- 5.** The event is a round of the **Motorsport UK British Championship** and the **BTRDA[®] Sporting Trials Championship & BTRDA[®] Allrounders Championship (permit no..**
- 6.** All drivers must produce a valid 2022 Motorsport UK Competition Licence and Championship Registration card (if applicable). **All passengers over 18 must produce a valid 2022 Motorsport UK Competition Licence and Club Membership card (BTRDA[®] Trials Passenger Membership cards will be accepted) as per T3.1.5. and those under 18 will be required to produce a letter of consent from a parent or guardian at signing-on, which will be retained by the Organisers as per T4.1.7.** Subject to Covid restrictions random checks will be carried out.
- 7.** The program for the event will be:

Scrutineering commences at **8.30 a.m** and will be visual subject to Covid restrictions.

Competitors not signed on by **10.15 a.m.** may be excluded

Drivers briefing at **10.15 a.m.**

The event will commence at **10.30 a.m.**

Public roads will not be used to link any of the sections. There will be a minimum of 8 sections on private land, each of which will be attempted three times. The entry will be split into groups, each will start at a different section, which will be announced at the drivers` briefing at 10.15 a.m. and displayed on the caravan window. The event will consist of six classes, Red Independent, Red Live Axle, Blue Independent, Blue Live Axle, Rookie and Post Historic. Competitors must indicate their Class on the enclosed Entry Form. A ballot will be carried out to determine the running order.

8. All vehicles must comply with the Motorsport UK Technical Regulations, the Motorsport UK National Trials Car Formula and be passed by the scrutineer. **You are reminded that all cars MUST be fitted with an electrical cut off switch mounted on the top right of the rear panel of the vehicle. Please note the only tyres allowed are: Nankang CX668, Toyo 330, Vredestein T-Trac 2 and Maxxis MA-510N, which are the tyres permitted by the Motorsport UK & BTRDA Championships. Post Historic class can use tyres in accordance with T14.8.1 & T14.8.2.** Minimum tyre pressures will be set at the drivers briefing and will be checked from time to time during the day, using the Club's pressure gauge.

Marking of penalties will be as printed in the appropriate section of the Motorsport UK General Regulations. Numbers will be allocated to each competitor as per **T5** and vehicles will be identified by number cards issued at signing-on.

9. Awards to Drivers & Passengers will be presented at the end of the event as follows:-

- First OverallThe Clee Hill Trophy
- First in Red Independent Class.....An Award for driver & passenger
- First in Red Live Axle Class.....An Award for driver & passenger
- First in Blue Independent Class.....An Award for driver & passenger
- First in Blue Live Axle Class.....An Award for driver & passenger
- First Rookie.....An Award for driver & passenger
- First Post Historic.....An Award for driver & passenger

10. Entries open on publication of these Regulations, and close on **Tuesday 15th February 2022.** **The Entry Fee is £45.00.** All entries must be made on the Official Motorsport UK Entry Form or the **online** form and accompanied by the appropriate fee or paid via **PayPal**. Cheques must be made out to "Hagley & District Light Car Club"

PLEASE ENTER EARLY, AS CHEQUES WILL NOT BE BANKED UNTIL AFTER THE EVENT AND FULL ENTRY FEE WILL BE REFUNDED PROVIDED NOTICE OF CANCELLATION IS RECEIVED 24 HOURS BEFORE THE EVENT START.

11. The maximum entry will be limited to **50** and the minimum will be **25**. The organisers reserve the right to cancel the event if less than **25** entries are received by the closing date. Final instructions and provisional entry lists will be sent immediately after closing date for entries by e-mail.
